2026 Agility Camp – August 21-23, 2026

DDTC’s 2026 Agility Camp features three experienced instructors — Judy Kolva, Deb Goodhart, and Cathy Markley — who use positive, reward-based training methods developed through years of work with top agility professionals. Each instructor brings extensive competitive experience and a passion for helping teams succeed.

• **Judy Kolva – Jumpers Skills**

Focus on common course patterns, discriminations, commitment, verbal handling, and efficient lines. Sessions emphasize active learning with course analysis and practical handling strategies.

• **Deb Goodhart – Standard Skills**

Work on handling lines, weave entries, tunnel skills, international handling, proofing, and reliable contact performance to build stronger, more confident teamwork.

• **Cathy Markley – Jumping & Motion**

Improve your dog’s jumping form through grids, flatwork, and motion exercises. Learn how timing and handler movement influence performance, bending, and turning skills.

Training groups will be organized by experience level, including Open/Excellent and Novice/Pre-Competition teams. Novice dogs should be comfortable sequencing 4–6 obstacles; contacts and weaves are not required. The camp will be held indoors with small-group instruction for maximum working time and individualized coaching. Saturday focuses on Standard skills with Deb, Sunday features Jumpers with Judy, and all participants will rotate through Cathy’s jumping sessions each day.
