PROPER STORAGE PLACEMENT OF AGILITY EQUIPMENT

The images begin with equipment stored to the left of the crating area on the South wall and continue left to the East and North walls.


Only the key pieces of equipment are named as there are too many tools used to call out, but the images will help show where those are stored.


Reference this document if unclear where to store an item. If you're not sure -- ASK ! If you're training alone, put it back it in the location where you found it if you can't find it in this document.


Note: All contact equipment must be gated off so dogs aren't tempted to "play" on it.










Tunnels

- Ensure 15' and 20' are stored on the cart labeled for their size
- Each cart is configured with the correct number of bags for that size tunnel. Do not swap bags between the different carts
- Park carts with the handle facing to the left, making it easier to pull carts out and push carts back into place







Store miscellaneous equipment in North East corner, i.e., jump double & triple, specialty jump stds, tunnel bags w/cart, chute.
