

DDTC POLICY ON RING GATE SET UP

All groups are responsible for **SETTING UP** the gates in the appropriate way for their activity. Depending on the group, that could mean setting up gates for rally, obedience, scent work or putting gates to the side as needed for agility.

Examples:

- For agility classes, the ring delineations are removed so there are no gates to impede setting up a course. The gates are placed to the side. When class is finished, the gates are not reset to form the separate rings.
- For the next performance class that comes in, they set up the gates how they need them for their activity. When they are finished, the gates remain in place as they set for their activity.

Instructors might need to ask their students to come a bit early to help with this process.
