DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE Keen Farm, 871 Crains Gap Rd., Carlisle, PA

From I-81 North: Take Exit 52, New Kingston/Middlesex: Turn right onto Route 11 South. Go about 6/10 of a mile and turn right onto North Middlesex Road by

Arby's and a donut shop. **From 81 South:** Take Exit 52, New Kingston/Middlesex: Turn left onto Route 11 South. Go to the third light and turn right onto North Middlesex Road by Arby's and a donut shop.

From North Middlesex Road go about 2/10 mile to left onto Clemson. Follow Clemson to stop sign. Turn right onto Wolfe's Bridge Road. Continue about 1 and ½ miles to right onto Spring Road. Then 2/10 mile to left onto Wagner Road. Go about 1 and 2/10 mile to right onto Crains Gap Road. Continue about 3/10 mile to right to the Keen Farm (#861 and #871 – Four Leaf Clover Farm). Look for tracking flags marking the entrance. Proceed past the covered bridge on left, two houses and a tennis court on right, two ponds and to the dog training facility.

Check in with tracking volunteers at the training facility for parking information.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

ENTRIES shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached, and a drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing to determine which entries will participate in the test.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES will be in the presence of the Tracking Test Committee at noon on Wednesday, October 15, 2025, at Dauphin Dog Training Club, 719 Manada Bottom Rd., Harrisburg, PA 17112, The drawing shall be completely at random among all the entries received

The Worker Option draw shall be conducted first Immediately after the Worker Option draw, any remaining test worker entries will be added to the non-worker entries for the draw of the remaining tracks. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on Alternate Lists corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances of other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash attached to a handler or confined to their crates except when being judged.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON Entrants must notify the Test Secretary and judges that their bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. Bitches in season will participate only after all other dogs have been tested.

REFUNDS. Entry Fees for an Alternate that does not participate in the Tracking Test shall be refunded within 7 days. In the event an accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date to allow an Alternate to replace said Entry, THE ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED. In the event an Accepted Entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no Alternate to replace said Entry, THE ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED. **IF** because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the test, NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- 5. Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
