Dauphin Dog Training Club held another successful Fast CAT trial at our club April 18-19. Fast CAT is a popular dog sport for everyone because it is FUN and requires no sport specific training to participate.

We received enthusiastic praise from our Canine participants! It was loud and proud!

Many dogs start "cheering" as soon as they enter the grounds. It's a wonder they can run after all of the energy expended during their wait time.

As the weekend went on, we realized once again that we are providing a community service for people and their dogs – particularly those who aren't caught up in the dog sports world! For those who do other sports, it's a chance to let go and have fun running your heart out. It's easy for the committee and volunteers to get excited watching the dogs and handlers have so much fun. That sense of joy is needed because everyone works hard and the days can be long.

The basic rules of the game are simple. Dogs receive points based on their time for running after a lure for 100 yards. The point system adjusts for height and stride length so all dogs can work for titles. The faster the dog runs, the more quickly they move through titles, but all dogs can earn a title. Some dogs chase the lure, others run to their handler. Handlers release the dog or meet the dog at the finish line. For those who don't have a second person, our committee helps them.



There is a challenge to running an event that requires little to no training for teams to participate. Many people and their dogs have not been to a performance event before and have not attended a sports class. The DDTC committee members received great praise from these participants for our helpfulness and support. We heard from many participants about how everyone was helpful and good humored! Some have participated in other Fast CAT trials and said ours was the most efficient and enjoyable.

There are also weather challenges when you work outside. We have hit some really bad days in the past. This weekend was beautiful in comparison.





# Dauphin Dog Training Club Board Meeting April 1 - 6:30 pm – At the Club

The Meeting was called to order by the President at 6:30 pm. Lisa and Lori had excused absences. Everyone else was present.

The March Board Meeting Minutes were approved as published.

The April Treasurers report will be approved via email later this week (See addendum)

The President called for an alternate order of business. Terry moved and Jane seconded. Motion carried.

The President reported that she mailed the PA Business Report to the Commonwealth.

Sharon Leh submitted a FOB approval including agility contact equipment for Donna Cikovic. Vicki moved to approve the application. Jane seconded. Motion approved.

#### First Vice President – Carolyn Dumaresq

Carolyn reported on the wear and tear of the tunnel bags and the safety of the dogs. Vicki moved that the club purchase four sets of tunnel bags for a total of \$240. John seconded. Motion carried. Carolyn noted that Sallie Jordan knows an Amish Saddlery by her home that may be able to repair the old tunnel bags. Vicki moved that \$150 be allotted to try and repair the old bags. Carolyn seconded. Motion Carried.

There was some questions regarding training fees, open training and FOBs. It was noted that the club has family memberships and when application is made for a FOB, all members under that family membership that are listed on the application do not have to pay for open training. It was also noted that FOBs and Open Training are a privilege for DDTC members and their dogs. Open training is not available for Non DDTC members or their dogs. It was also noted that NO private lessons are permitted at the Club at any time.

The Board noted that the job needs to be done and Vicki will find a time in the future that will have minimum effect on the club.

John thanked Carolyn for meeting with the HVAC contractors for the installation of the WiFi thermostats. There are three people that will have access to the thermostats, the First and Second VP and the Building/Grounds manager. If there is any issue for the temperature in the building one of these three people should be contacted. It was also noted that the Board had approved in the past that the temperature setting for the winter is 68 degrees and for the summer 72 degrees.

Jane handed out the statistics for the obedience spring class session. There were 18 classes (including 3 new classes) offered and 10 were full with wait lists. This was a total of 107 students.

#### Supplies – Lauren Zagnit

Lauren is working with Deb Sorosky to replace and reorganize the cabinets with scent work supplies. It was noted that just like agility, there should be criteria for using the scent work supplies. Jane will discuss this with Deb.

#### IT – Lisa Hetzel

Lisa submitted a written report.

Su and Lisa have completed the organization of the Google Cloud and have started uploading files. The thumb drive files submitted by the President have been uploaded. Heidi (Barker) and Lori (Recording Secretary) are going to submit the files they have.

It was noted that Skype will be going away in May. Microsoft is offering Teams as a new option. Another option is Google Meet.

Informational sheets on the selections were distributed to the board members. Board members were encouraged to review the information handed out and submit their comments. It was noted that Ruthann just installed Agility Great Mats at The Barn. The subcommittee was unaware of this and they are going to contact her.
